

The “Nail It Program or How to Keep TI-SmartView Always On Top!

1. Download the Nail It program to your desktop.

Obtain the program from:

www.TomReardon.com Click on Downloads Scroll to nail.exe (towards the bottom)

2. Execute the program.

3. It will place an icon on your command line at the bottom of your windows screen. It will either look like a piece of lined paper or a piece of paper with a tack on it.

4. Have TI-SmartView (or what ever application you want to be "always on top") running.

5. Right click on the Nail It icon (it looks like a piece of paper, with or without a tack in it).

6. Choose "Nail" with the right click button.

7. Right click on SmartView (or other application) – it will have the tack pointing at the image.

8. That should do it.

N. B. If you want, you can have the Nail It program be part of your Start Up programs (if you know how to do that). In that case, the icon will always be on your command line, but you still have to do steps 4 through 8.
